Two District Goals

 - Transition-proof district (better prepare for a situation like we had this summer where so many central office employees needed hiring)

3). Personal & Professional Practice Goal

First time as superintendent in the state of MA. Enrolled in new superintendent training and has a mentor who she meets with six hours per month.

4). Student Goal

In the process of assessing multi-tiered support system in an effort to better serve all students. Pay particular attention to special education students.

Main concern is the budget but will have a better understanding of the budget after a full budget cycle and assess needs. Hoping to create a budget book. Each principal will present a proposal of their needs and prioritize pre-K-12. Concerns about the condition of track and fields at HWRHS. Discussion about recognizing religious holidays - staff should be understanding & inclusive.

Principal's Update (Craig Hovey, MRMS)

Open House - large turnout, preference for scheduled based model as far as the structure as opposed to team model. Recommendation for the Friends group to provide refreshments. **Allergy Aware School -** Several cases of life-threatening allergies at MRMS this year. Heightened awareness - no food containing nuts in the classrooms; new cleaning protocol in the cafeteria:

ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter and Evacuate) School Safety Drills

ALICE Parent Information Meeting - September 25th - roughly 60 parents attended All HWRSD staff trained in ALICE

Student drill - later this year - parents will be informed first

Wellness Fair - October 5th - Well attended. This will be held every 2 years - but need to determine the best time to hold it

School Committee Workshops: Great conversations - more work with school committee, teachers and the community.

Aspen Forms: MRMS rolled out online verification forms to make the process more efficient and so important medical/contact info can be updated much faster. All schools will eventually use this online system to update information.
